COVID-19 FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Rent Relief and Housing Assistance Program

Do you need rent assistance? The State of Hawaii's Rent Relief and Housing Assistance Program provides assistance to Hawaii renters and homeowners who have experienced a reduction in income due to the disruption caused by the COVID-19 pandemic and are at risk of eviction or foreclosure. The program provides help with housing payments as well as assistance in financial counseling and loan modification. Funded by the Federal CARES Act, the program is administered by Catholic Charities Hawaii. Applications for assistance will be accepted for housing payments due between August 1, 2020 and December 15, 2020. Applications are due by December 15, 2020.

Eligibility

Full-time Hawaii residents with a valid and current lease agreement for their primary residence or who own and occupy a housing unit in Hawaii must show a loss of income due to the COVID-19 pandemic and have a gross household income that does not exceed 100% of the HUD Area Median Income for 2020.

For Eligible Renters

- Monthly rent payments of up to \$1,500 per household residing in Maui County.
- Any applicable financial counseling and assistance with rent payment plans or rent negotiation.
- Payments will be made directly to the landlord.

For Eligible Homeowners

- Financial and housing counseling services, which include budgeting and foreclosure mitigation.
