Depart Los Angeles

at 7:10 PM.

Monday, January 5, 2026

Zurich

Arrive at Zurich Airport at 3:15 PM. Depart from Zurich on flight LX1732 at 5:35 PM, arriving in Rome at 7:10 PM. Dinner at the hotel and overnight stay.

Tuesday, January 6, 2026

Celebration at St. Peter's Basilica, St. Paul Outside the Walls

Transfer to St. Peter's Square to enter the Holy Door and attend the Epiphany celebrations at the Basilica. Continue to the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls, originally founded by Emperor Constantine in the 4th century, where the Apostle Paul is buried. Return to the hotel Saturday, January 10, 2026 for dinner and overnight stay.

Wednesday, January 7, 2026

Papal Audience, Vatican Museums

Transfer to Vatican City to join pilgrims from around the world for an audience with His Holiness, the Pope (subject to the Holy Father's schedule and health). Visit the Vatican Museums, including the Tapestry Gallery, Raphael Rooms, and the Sistine Chapel, featuring Michelangelo's masterpiece. Continue to St. Peter's Basilica to enter our second Holy Door. Mass will be celebrated in a local church. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight stay.

Thursday, January 8, 2026

Basilicas, Fountains & Squares

Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of St. Mary

Major, one of the four major basilicas built by Pope Sixtus III (AD 432-440). View its We will depart from Los Angeles on flight LX41 impressive interior, ancient Christian mosaics, and relics of Jesus' manger from Bethlehem. Visit the Cathedral of St. John Lateran, the first Christian church to be consecrated, founded by Emperor Constantine in the 4th century. Visit the Holy Stairs. Free afternoon to explore the city independently. Visit Navona Square, Trevi Fountain, and the Spanish Steps. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight stay.

Friday, January 9, 2026

Orvieto, Assisi

Depart the hotel and drive approximately 1.5 hours to Orvieto to visit the Gothic Cathedral, which houses the holy relics of the Eucharistic Miracle of Orvieto. Continue to Assisi. Check-in at the hotel, dinner, and overnight stay.

Assisi

isit the Basilica of Saint Mary of the Angels, which houses the Porziuncola, or Little Portion Chapel. Continue to the Basilica of St. Clare to view her remains and the miraculous Crucifix. Visit the Sanctuary of Espoliazione to see the body of Blessed Carlo Acutis, an Italian teenager known for his deep devotion to the Eucharist and his efforts to document Eucharistic miracles online. Carlo, who referred to the Eucharist as his "highway to heaven," spent much of his adolescence in prayer and adoration. He created a website cataloging Eucharistic miracles, aiming to inspire others to develop a closer relationship with the Eucharist. Carlo passed away from a brain tumor in 2006

at the age of 15. Conclude with a visit to the Basilica of St. Francis, which features Giotto's monumental frescoes and the crypt housing St. Francis' tomb. Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel.

Sunday, January 11, 2026

Assisi, Lanciano, San Giovanni Rotondo

Depart for Lanciano, site of a Eucharistic Miracle. Celebrate Mass and continue to San Giovanni Rotondo. Check-in, dinner, and overnight stay.

Monday, January 12, 2026

San Giovanni Rotondo & St. Michael's Cave

Celebrate Mass at the Church of Santa Maria delle Grazie. Visit sites associated with Padre Pio, including his tomb, cell, confessional, and the old Santa Maria delle Grazie Church. Continue to the Grotto of St. Michael the Archangel. Celebrate Mass. Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel.

Tuesday, January 13, 2026

San Giovanni Rotondo, Naples, Barcelona

Check out and drive to Naples for a flight to Barcelona on Vueling Airlines at 2:15 PM. Upon arrival, enjoy leisure time in Barcelona. Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel.

Wednesday, January 14, 2026

Barcelona

Guided city tour of Barcelona, including the Sagrada Familia, Passeig de Gràcia, Plaza Catalunya, Montjuïc, and the Gothic Quarter with Barcelona's Cathedral. Celebrate Mass. Afternoon at leisure. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight stay.

Thursday, January 15, 2026

Barcelona, Zaragoza

Depart for Zaragoza. Visit the Basilica of Our Lady of the Pillar, where we will celebrate Mass. Check-in at the hotel, dinner, and overnight stay.





Friday, January 16, 2026

Zaragoza, Avila

Check out and drive to Avila (approximately 5.5 hours). Upon arrival, check in at the hotel. In the afternoon, visit sites related to St. Teresa's life, including the Cathedral and the Convent of St. Teresa, where relics of St. Teresa and St. John of the Cross are kept. Attend Mass. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight stay.

Saturday, January 17, 2026

Avila, Santarem, Fatima

Depart Avila for Portugal. Stop in Santarem to visit the Eucharistic Miracle Church and celebrate Mass. Continue to Fatima. Check-in at the hotel, dinner, and overnight stay.

Sunday, January 18, 2026

Fatima

Attend the ceremonies for the Anniversary of the Apparitions of the Virgin Mary. In the afternoon, visit the Chapel of the Apparitions, the Basilica, and the tombs of Francisco, Jacinta, and Sr. Lucia. Visit the Monument to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. In Aljustrel and Valinhos, see the homes of the little shepherds and the site of the first and third visits of the Angel of Peace. Stop at the Parish Church and cemetery where Francisco and Jacinta were once buried. After dinner, participate in a candlelight procession.

Monday, January 19, 2026

Depart Portugal

Depart from Lisbon on flight LH1781 at 6:10 AM, arriving in Munich at 10:15 AM. Depart from Munich on flight LH452 at 12:00 PM, arriving in Los Angeles at 3:15 PM.
